Covid Policy

In order to ensure the health & safety of all guests we have the following guideline in place:

- **If you are feeling ill, PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND CLASSES OR EVENTS AT BIZZY BEE.**
- **Everyone entering the facility must receive a temperature reading. Anyone displaying signs of illness, including a temperature of 100.4 or higher, will be kindly asked to postpone their class and return for a makeup.**
- **All participants are asked to use the restrooms and wash hands thoroughly before the start of class/event.**
- **Only one parent or non-participating responsible adult guardian must escort a child into the facility to assist with check in, health screening and class preparation.**
- **Class participants are asked to bring minimal personal belongings in a small drawstring size bag into the facility. The bag will be placed into locker/cubby and stored there while the participant is in class. Cubbies will be cleaned and sanitized after each use.**
- **Spectator viewing is socially distanced.**
- **Classes will be taught using stations that are socially distanced (when possible).**
- **Class participants will sanitize hands before and after entering the play room.**
- **Class stations and equipment will be cleaned and sanitized after each use.**
- **No water fountains will be available on site. Participants need to bring their own water bottles that contain water only.**
- **No food is allowed on site (unless approved for a part**

Also, please note that per Governor Pritzger's recent changes in mask requirements, I do have to REQUIRE that all adults wear them in Bizzy Bee at all times, and that children (over 2) wear upon entering and exiting and are encouraged to where as much as possible (minus when eating, etc.). As a business owner, if these guidelines are not followed I could be fined and shut down, so it is very important to make people aware and to try to help ensure the safety of all who attend Bizzy Bee.
